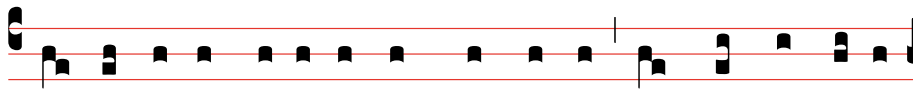

H ave mer- cy up-on me, O God : af-ter thy great goodness.

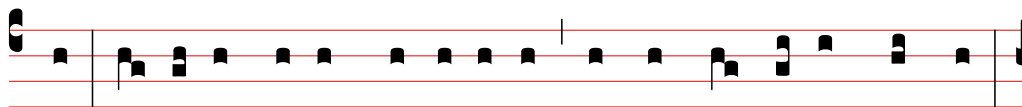
8. Thou shalt make me hear *of* joy and *glad*-ness : that the bones which thou hast brok-*en* may rejoice.
