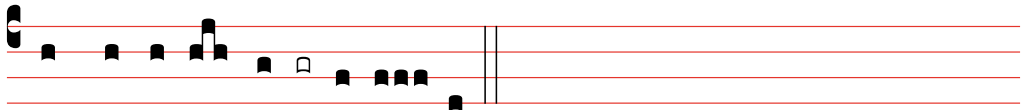
One or more psalm verses and a Glory Be may be sung in alternation with the antiphon.

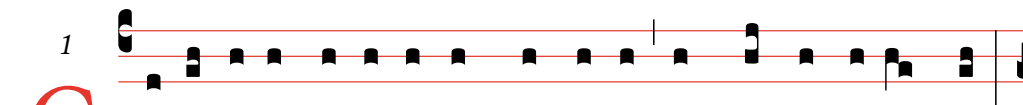

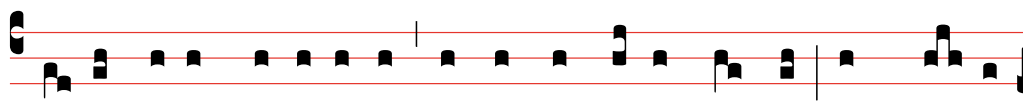

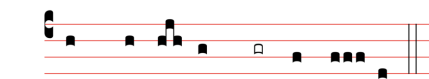
