
The antiphon may be alternated with one or more of the following verses and a Glory Be.



Lord: ascribe unto the Lord worship and strength.

- 2. Give the Lord the hon-*our* due un-*to* his Name : worship the Lord *with* holy worship.
- 3. It is the Lord that com-*mand*-eth the *wat*-ers : it is the glorious God that *mak*-eth the thunder.
- 4. It is the Lord that ruleth the sea; the voice of the Lord is mighty *in* oper-*a*-tion: the voice of the Lord is *a* glo-ri-ous voice.
- 5. The voice of the Lord *break*-eth the *ce*-dar-trees : yea, the Lord breaketh the ce-*dars* of Libanus.
- 7. The voice of the Lord divideth the flames of fire; the voice of the Lord *shak*-eth the *wil*-derness: yea, the Lord shaketh the wil-*der*-ness of Cades.
- 9. The Lord sitteth *a*-bove the *wa*-ter-flood : and the Lord remaineth *a* King for ever.
