


Communion Antiphon for Divine Worship






will we give thanks unto him: be-cause he hath done unto us af-ter

One or more psalm verses and a Glory Be may be sung in alternation with the antiphon (see over).





- 3. Acknowledge him before the nations, *O* sons of *Is*-rael : for he has scatter'd *us* among them.
- 5. He will afflict us for our iniquities; and again *he* will show *mer*-cy: and will gather us from all the nations among whom you *have* been scatter'd.
- *6a.* If you turn to him with all your heart and with all your soul, to do what *is* true be-*fore* him : then he will turn to you and will not hide *his* face from you.
- 6b. But see what he will do with you; give thanks to him with your full voice: Praise the Lord of righteousness, and exalt the King of the ages.
- *6c.* I give him thanks in the land *of* my cap-*tiv*-ity : and I show his power and majesty to a na-*tion* of sinners.
- *6d.* Turn back, you sinners, and *do* right be-*fore* him; who knows if he will accept you and have *mer*-cy on you?
 - 7. I exalt my God; my soul exalts *the* King of *heav*-en : and will rejoice in *his* majesty.
