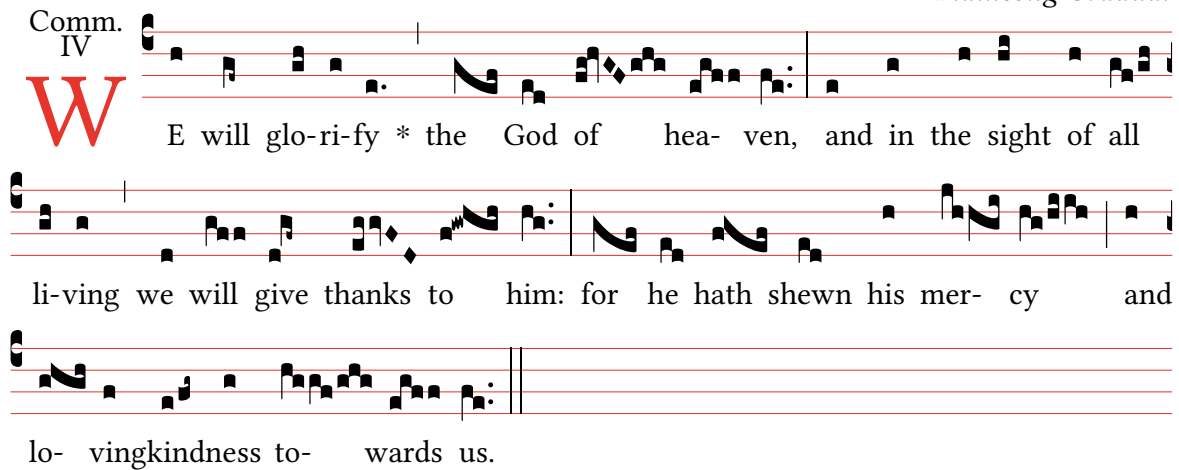

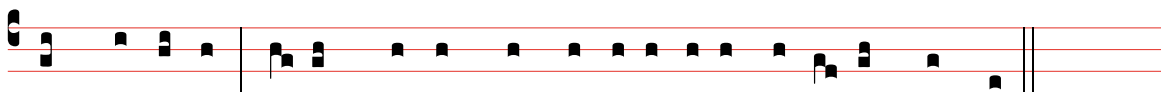

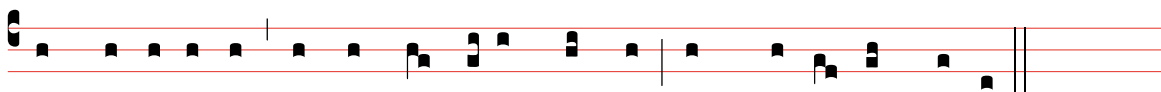
LESSED is God *who* lives for *ev-* er: and blessed *is* his kingdom.

- 6d. Turn back, you sinners, and *do* right be-*fore* him; who knows if he will accept you and have *mer-cy* on you?
7. I exalt my God; my soul exalts *the* King *of* *heav-en* : and will rejoice in *his* majesty.
