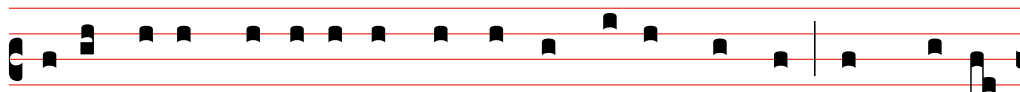
2. When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me *to* eat up my flesh : - | *they* stumbled and fell.
