The antiphon may be alternated with one or more verses and a Glory Be.

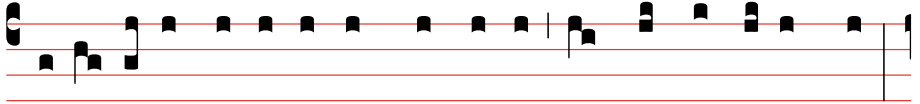
Ps. 81:1-4,11,14,17

11. I am the Lord thy God, who brought thee out of *the* land of *Eg*-ypt : open thy mouth wide, *and* I shall fill it.

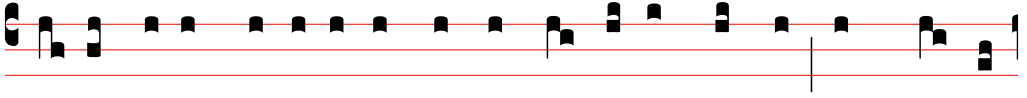
