The antiphon may be alternated with one or more verses and a Glory Be.

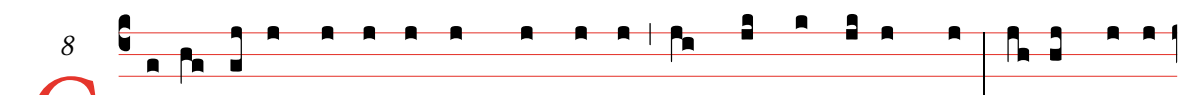

21. My lips will be fain when I sing un-to thee : and so will my soul whom *thou* hast deliv ◦ -erèd.

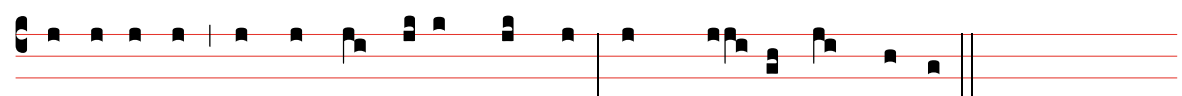
