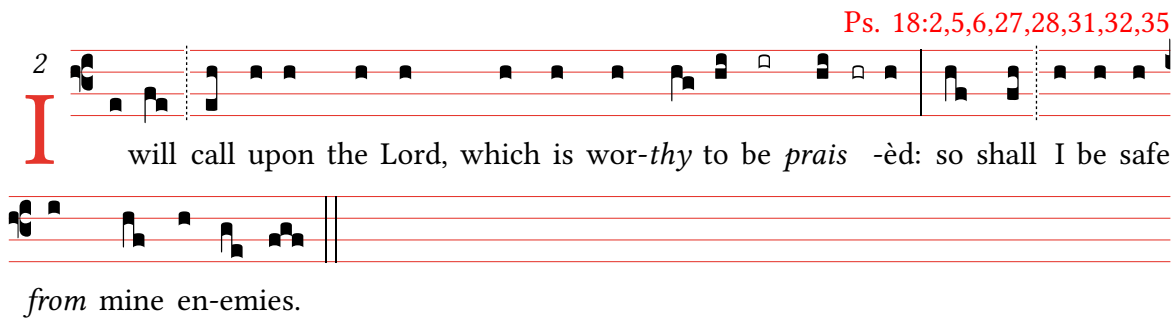
Psalm Tone



HE Lord is my strong rock, and my de-fence: my saviour, my God, and my might.

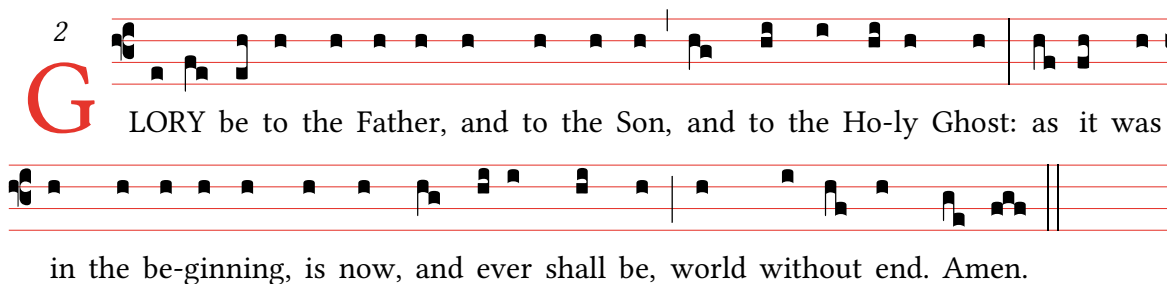
One or more psalm verses and a Glory Be may be sung in alternation with the antiphon.
