
One or more psalm verses and a Glory Be may be sung in alternation with the antiphon.

- 3. But let the righteous be glad and re-*joice* be-*fore* God : let them also be mer-ry and joyful.
- 4. O sing unto God, and sing praises un-to his Name: magnify him that rideth upon the heavens, as it were upon an horse; praise him in his Name, and re-joice before him.
