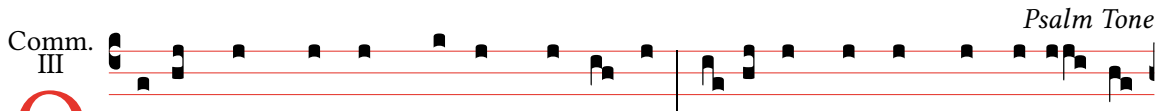

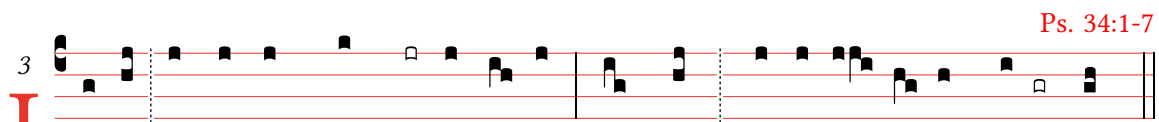

One or more psalm verses and a Glory Be may be sung in alternation with the antiphon.

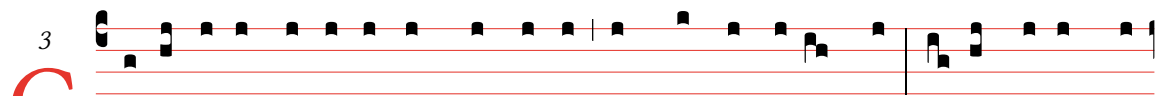

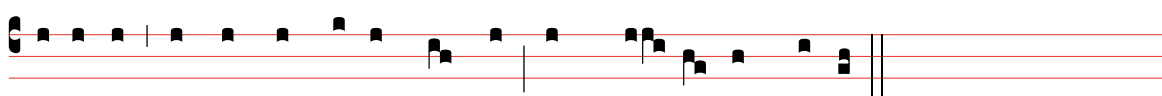
I will alway give *thanks* unto *the* Lord: his praise shall ev-er be in my mouth.
