confusion, de-liv-er me *in* thy righteous-ness.

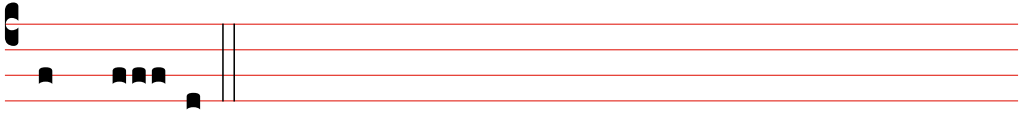
1. Bow down thine *ear* to me : make haste *to* deliver me.
