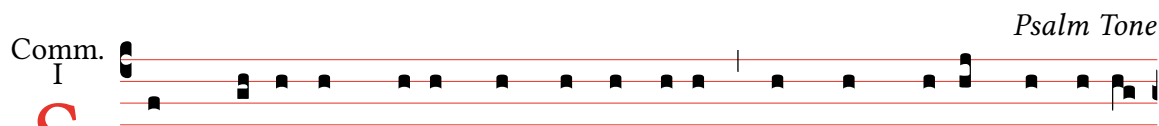

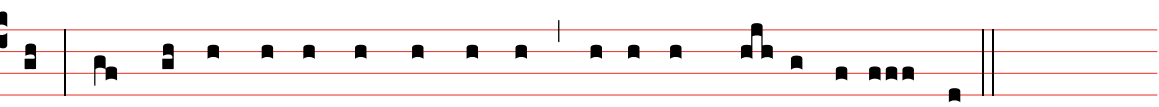

The antiphon may be alternated with one or more of the following verses and a Glory Be.

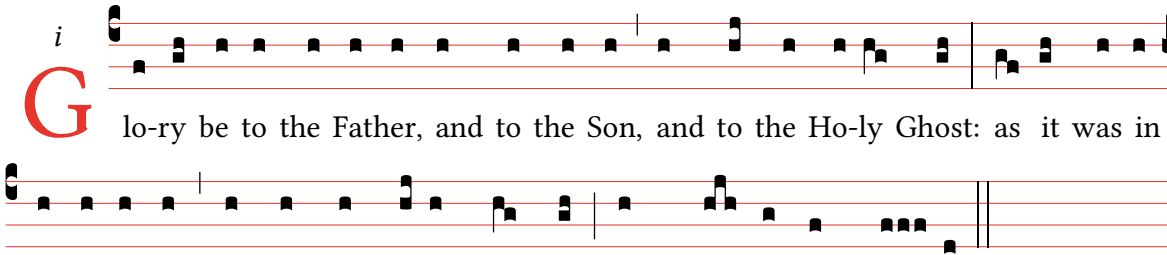
i **I** n thee, O Lord, have I *put* my trust: let me never be put to confusion, de-liv-er me *in* thy righteous-ness.
