I n thee, O *Lord*, have I *put* my trust: let me never be put to confusion, de-liv-er  
me in *thy* righteousness.

3. And be thou my strong rock, *and* house of defence : - | that thou *may*-est save me.
6. Into thy hands I *com*-mend my *spir*-it : for thou hast redeemed me, O Lord, *thou* God of truth.
