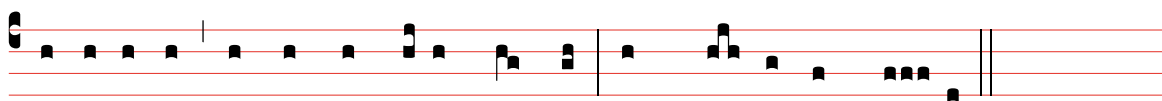


Hear my law, *O* my *peop*-le: incline your ears un-to the words of my mouth.

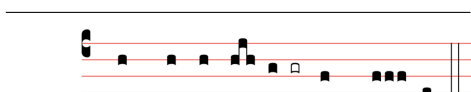
- 3-4. Which we have heard and known, and such as our *fath*-ers have *told* us : that we should not hide them from the children of the *gén*-er-ations¹ to come;
