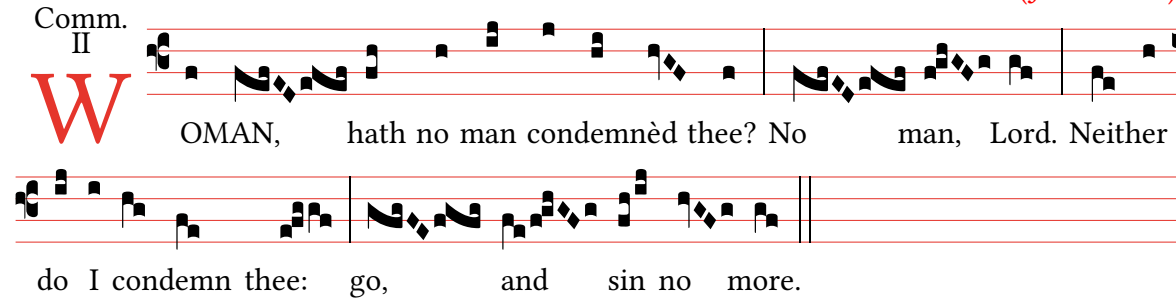


Communion Antiphon for Divine Worship

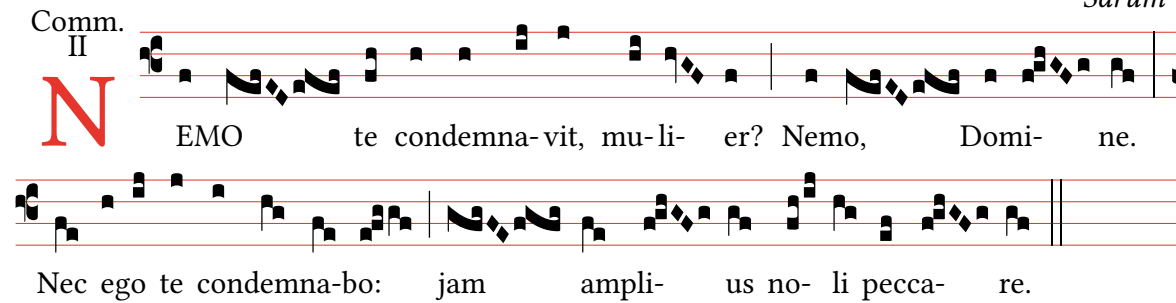
OMAN, hath no man condemnèd thee? No man, Lord. Neither

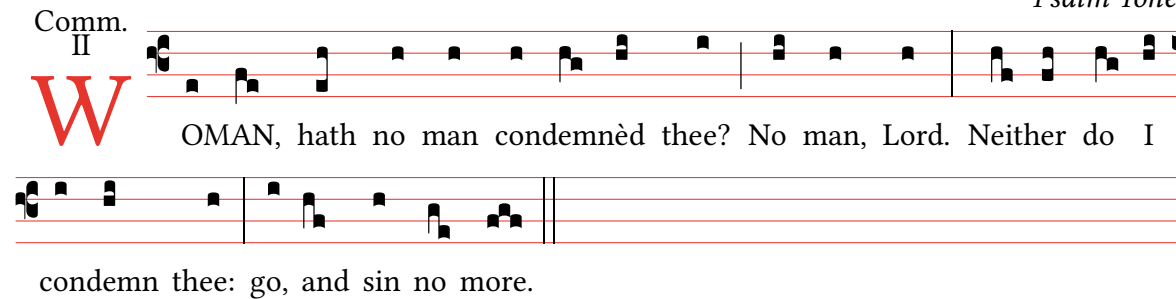
