- 5. I will acknowledge *my* sin un-to thee : and mine unrighteous-ness have I not hid.
- 6. I said, I will confess *my* sins un-to the Lord : and so thou forgavest the wick-*ed*-ness of my sin.
- 9. I will inform thee, and teach thee in the *way* wherein *thou* shalt go: and I will *guide* thee with mine eye.
- 11. Great plagues remain *for* the un-*god*-ly: but whoso putteth his trust in the Lord, mercy embraceth *him* on ev'ry side.
- *12.* Be glad, O ye righteous, and *re*-joice *in* the Lord : and be joyful, all *ye* that are true of heart.²
