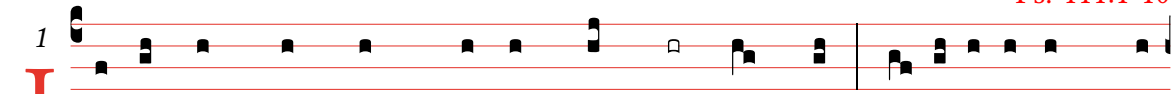

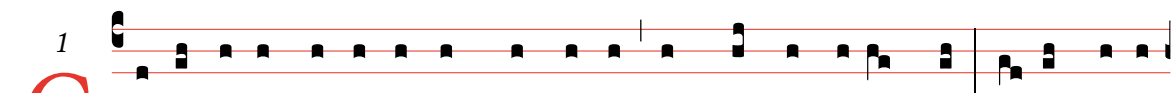

Ps. 111:1-10

1  **I** will give thanks unto the Lord *with my whole* heart: secretly among the faithful, and in *the* congrega- tion.

2. The works of the *Lord* are great : sought out of all them that *have* pleasure therein.
3. His work is worthy to be praised and *had* in *hon*-our : and his righteousness en-*dur*-eth for ever.
4. The merciful and gracious Lord hath so done his *mar*-vel-*lous* works : that they ought to be *had* in remembrance.
5. He hath given meat unto *them* that *fear* him : he shall ever be mindful of his covenant.
- 6-7. He hath shewèd his people the power of his works, that he may give them the heritage of the *heath*-en : the works of his hands are ver-*i*-ty and judgement.
- 7-8. All his commandments are true, they stand fast for *ev*-er and *ev*-er : and are done in *truth* and equity.
9. He sent redemption un-*to* his *peo*-ple : he hath commanded his cov-*e*-nant for ever.
- 9-10. Holy and rever-*end* is *his* Name : the fear of the Lord is the be-*gin*-ning of wisdom.
10. A good understanding have all they that *do* there-*aft*-er : the praise of it en-*dur*-eth for ever.
