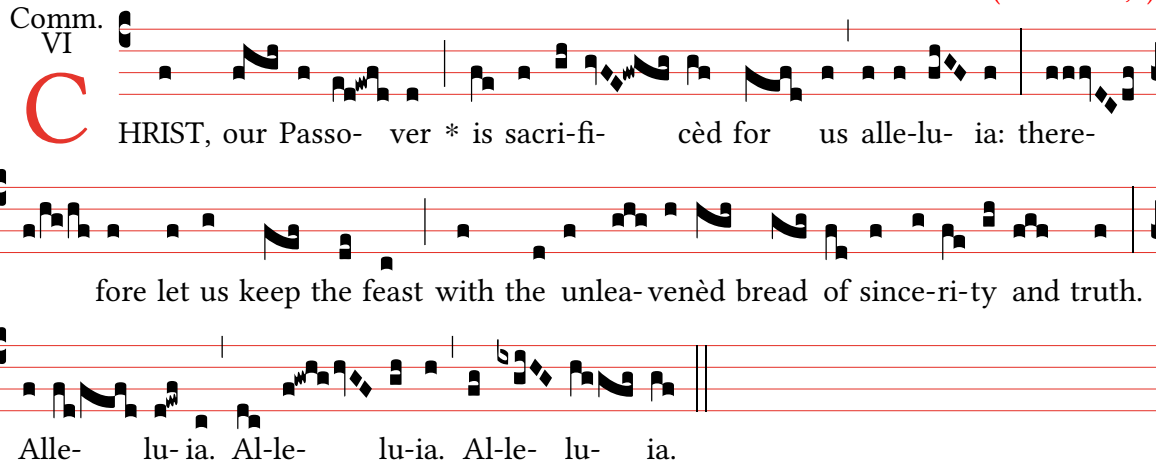

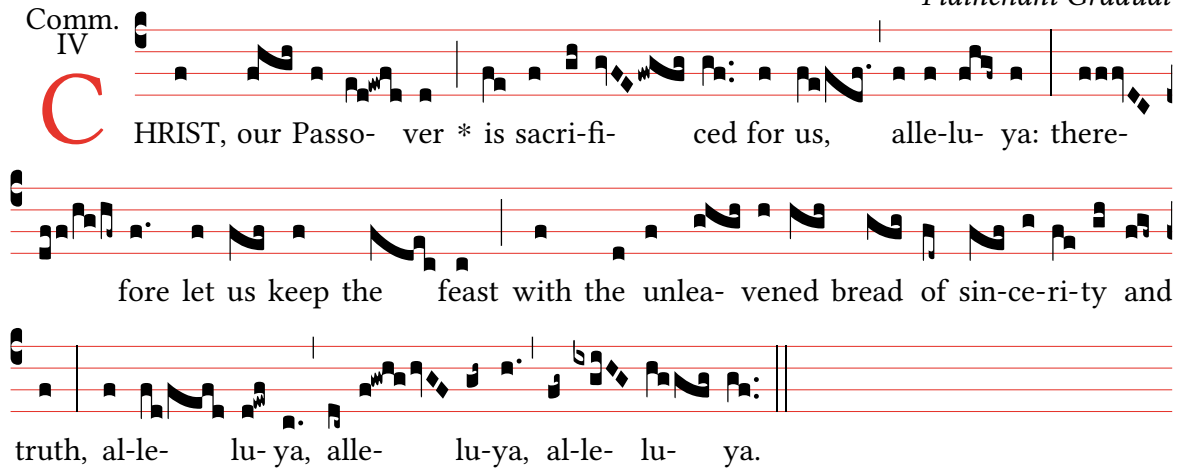


CHRIST, our Passover * is sacrificed for us alleluia: therefore let us keep the feast with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

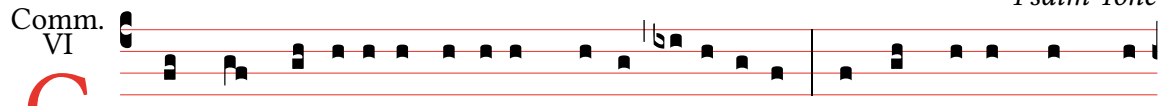

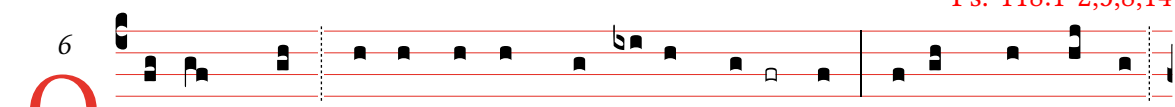

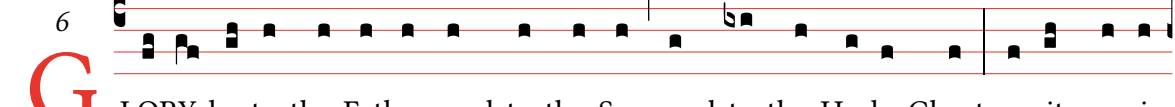
