



Communion Antiphon for Divine Worship

- 4. O sing unto God, and sing praises un-*to his* Name: magnify him that rideth upon the heavens, as it were upon an horse; praise him in his Name, and *re*-joice before him.

- 18. Thou art gone up on high, thou hast led captivity captive, and re-*ceiv*-èd gifts *for* men : yea, even for thine enemies, that the Lord God *might* dwell among them.
- *19.* Praised be the *Lord dai*-ly: even the God who helpeth us, and poureth his ben-*e*-fits upon us.
- *20.* He is our God, even the God of whom *com*-eth sal-*va*-tion : God is the Lord, by *whom* we escape death.
- 24. It is well seen, O God, *how* thou *go*-est : how thou, my God and King, goest *in* the sanctuary.
- 28. Thy God hath sent forth *strength for* thee : stablish the thing, O God, that *thou* hast wrought in us.
- *29.* For thy temple's sake *at* Jeru-*sa*-lem : so shall kings bring *pres*-ents unto thee.
