I will give thanks to thee, O Lord, for though thou wast an-



gry *with* me, thy anger turned away, and *thou* didst comfort me.

- 2a. Behold, God is *my* sal-va-tion : I will trust, and *will* not be afraid.
- 2b. For the Lord God is *my strength* and *my* song : and he has be-come my salvation.
3. With joy you *will* draw wa-ter : from the *wells* of salvation.

- 4a. And you will *say* in *that* day : Give thanks to the Lord, *call* upon his name.
- 4b. Make known his deeds a-*mong* the *na*-tions : proclaim that his *name* is exalted.
5. Sing praises to the Lord, for he has done *glo-ri-ous*-ly : let this be *known* in all the earth.
6. Shout, and sing for joy, O inhabit-*ant* of *Zi*-on : for great in your midst is the Holy *One* of Isra-el.
