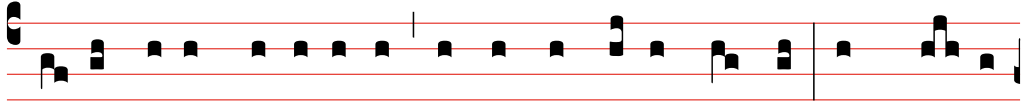
2. For he hath founded it up-*on the* seas : and preparèd *it* upon the floods.

8. - | Who is the *King* of *glo-ry* : it is the Lord strong and mighty, even the Lord *migh-ty* in battle.

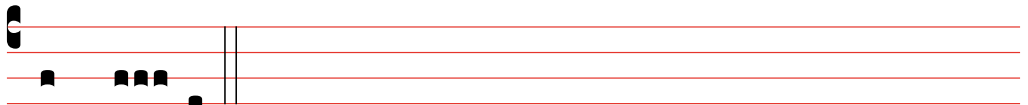
