no-sti: tu scis, Dó- mi- ne, qui- a a- mo te. *T.P.* Al-le- lu- ia.

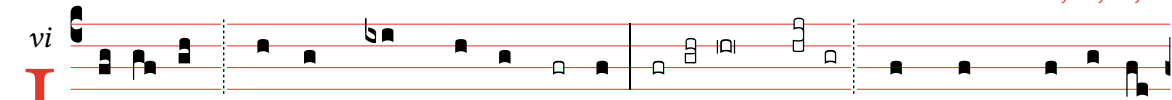
Psalm Tone

One or more psalm verses and a Glory Be may be sung in alternation with the antiphon.

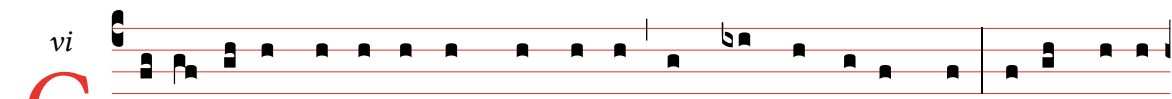
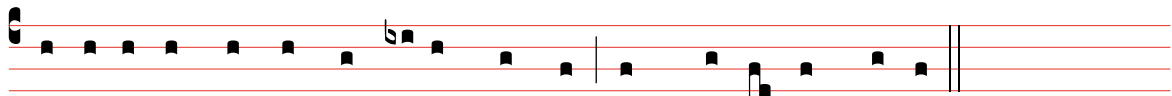

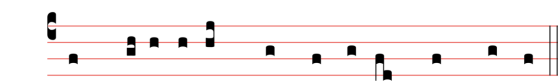
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I will al -way *give* thanks unto the Lord: - | his praise shall *ev-er*
