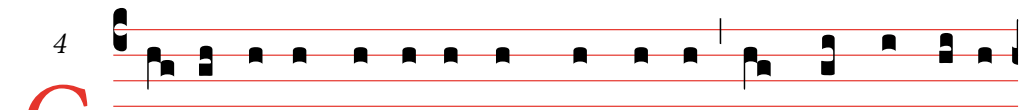
O sing unto *the* Lord a *new* song : sing unto the Lord, *all*



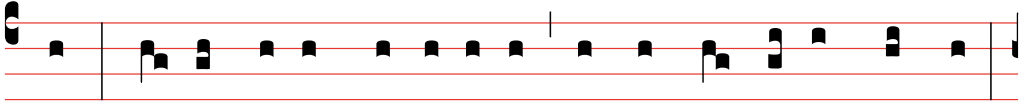

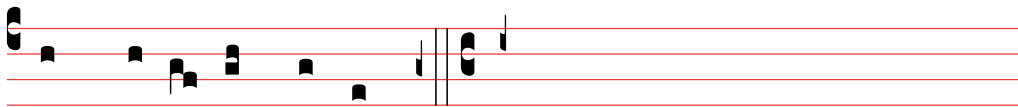
