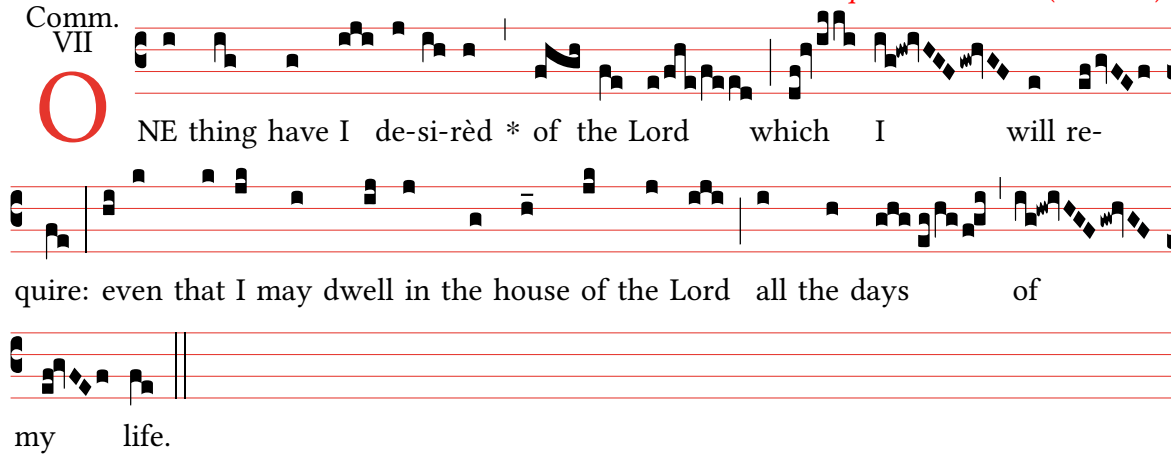

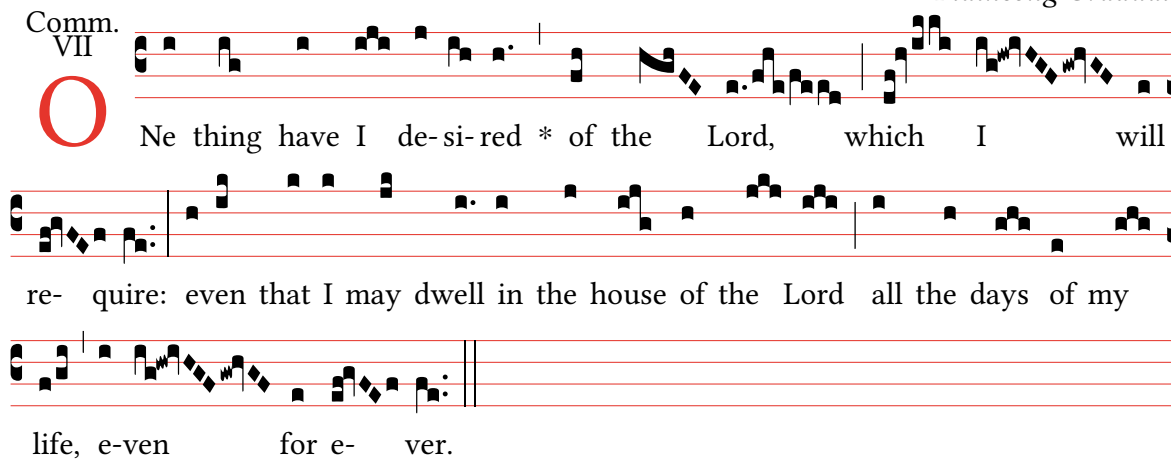

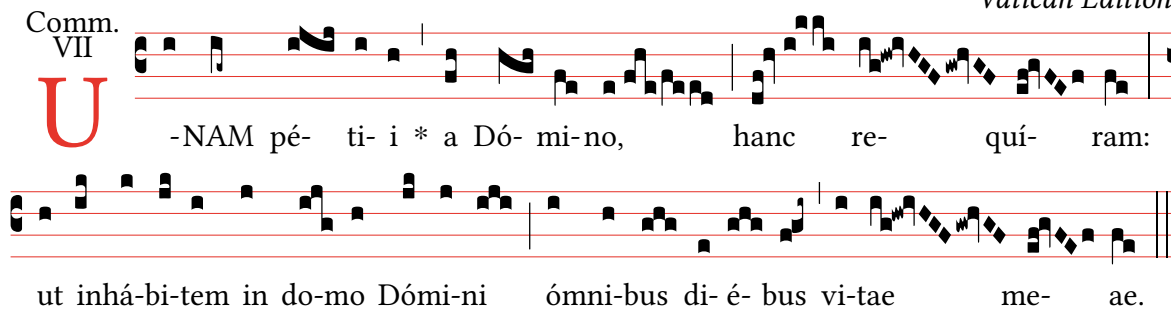

Comm. VII Psalm Tone

ONE thing have I de-sir-èd of the Lord, which I will require : ev-en that I
may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life.

One or more psalm verses and a Glory Be may be sung in alternation with the antiphon.

7 Ps. 27:1-3,10,11,13,15,16
The Lord is my light and my sal- va-tion: - whom then shall I fear?

1. The Lord is the *strength* of my life; of whom then *shall* I be afraid?
2. When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to *eat up my* flesh : - | *they* stumbled and fell.
3. Though an host of men were *laid a-against* me : yet shall not *my* heart be afraid.
3. And though there rose up *war a-against* me : yet will I *put* my trust in him.
10. O hide not thou thy *face from* me : nor cast thy servant a-way in displeasure.
11. - | Thou hast *been* my *suc-cour* : leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.
13. Teach me thy *way*, O Lord : and lead me in the right way, because of mine enemies.
